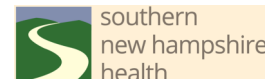

Wendy L. Wright, MS, ANP-BC, FNP-BC, FAANP, FAAN, FNAP

Wendy Wright is a 1992 graduate of the Adult Primary Care Nurse Practitioner program at Simmons College in Boston, Massachusetts and completed a family nurse practitioner post-master's program in 1995. She is an adult and family nurse practitioner and the owner of two, nurse practitioner owned and operated clinics in New Hampshire: Wright & Associates Family Healthcare located in Amherst and Concord. In addition, she is the Owner of Partners in Healthcare Education, a medical education company. In 2005, she was inducted as a Fellow into the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners; in October 2014, a Fellow in the American Academy of Nursing, and in March 2017, a Fellow into the National Academies of Practice. She is the founder of the NH Chamber of Entrepreneurial Nurse Practitioners, an organization designed to assist nurse practitioners with independent practice issues. In addition to full-time clinical practice, she presents nationally to different audiences and has been a speaker at over 1000 conferences in 46 states.



Alexander B. Granok, MD, FACP

Dr. Granok received his undergraduate degree from the University of Denver, and his medical degree from the University of New Mexico School of Medicine. He completed his residency in Internal Medicine at Barnes Hospital and his Fellowship in Infectious Diseases at Washington University in St. Louis. He and his family moved to New Hampshire in 2001, after two years in Bangor, ME. He has been practicing with Infectious Disease Associates, in Merrimack, since 2001, and has been associated with the Nashua Department of Health and Community Services since 2002, when he was appointed to the Board of Health.
