## CHW APPRENTICESHIP

### CHW ADVANCE! APPRENTICESHIP

CHW Advance! is a HRSA funded program to enhance the CHW Workforce. The CHW Apprenticeship provides the opportunity for increased training and on the job experience for new and existing CHWs in NH. Employers can get additional support for CHWs and can promote retention through Apprenticeship.

### CHW APPRENTICESHIP ELEMENTS:

This one year Apprenticeship provides CHW with:

- 144 hours of paid training
- 2000 hours on the job training
- Mentoring support
- Regular Competency Assessment
- \$1,500 to cover mileage
- \$7,500 stipend for CHW

Employers receive:

- Reimbursement for on-the-job training wages up to \$2,000 per apprentice
- \$4,000 in incentive funding from Apprenticeship NH



## Steps for Apprenticeship:

1. Contact us for help in registering with the Department of Labor as an Apprenticeship site.
2. Complete the DOL Apprenticeship Intake form.
3. Register with ApprenticeshipNH to access supportive services.
4. Engage your CHW in OJT and related instruction.
